

# Alabama National Guard Benefits

## Education

### *o Alabama National Guard Education Assistance Program (ANGEAP)*

*ANGEAP is an award to be used for tuition and educational fees for Alabama National Guard members to attend a postsecondary educational institution in Alabama. The award is based on financial need. This award is for students who are active members in good standing with a federally-recognized unit of the Alabama National Guard.*

### *o GI Bill (CH 1606)*

*The GI Bill provides \$384 per month for 36 months for full-time college students. This amount is paid directly to the student, not the institution.*

### *o Student Loan Repayment Program (SLRP)*

*The Student Loan Repayment Program (SLRP) is available to members of the Alabama National Guard who have one or more qualifying and disbursed Title IV federal loan(s). Up to \$50,000 can be contributed towards student loan repayment.*

### *o Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA)*

*Federal Tuition Assistance provides \$250 maximum per semester hour for college students. The annual ceiling cap for FTA is \$4,500.*

## Insurance

### *o TRICARE*

*TRICARE is the health care program designed for service members, retirees, and their families.*

*TRICARE provides a selection of comprehensive coverage types to all beneficiaries.*

### *o Servicemembers' Group Life Insurance (SGLI)*

*SGLI provides Soldiers with low -cost coverage for life insurance.*

### *o Family SGLI (FSGLI)*

*FSGLI provides Soldiers and their families with low-cost life insurance coverage. Coverage can include spouses and dependent children of Soldiers .*
